

Consultation over new homes plan

PLANS to build 450 homes and a retirement complex in County Durham will go on display next month.

UK investment business ESRG is inviting residents to have their say on its proposal to build 218 homes, including executive, family and affordable properties, on land off Beacon Lane, Sedgfield.

Plans have also been drawn up for a 60-bed retirement complex at the same location to deliver extra-care for older residents.

The scheme also includes a proposal to build a further 232 homes off

Salters Lane, with the sale of these properties helping to fund a business hub and new education, health and training facilities, such as a GP or dentist surgery.

A public consultation event will be held at Sedgfield Racecourse, in County Durham, next Wednesday and on Monday, May 12, between 3pm and 8pm.
